## PROCESS FOR OPENING A BUSINESS IN CHEVIOT

## ITEMS ARE NOT LISTED IN ANY SPECIFIC ORDER

- 1. Check with the Building Inspector at Cheviot City Hall to determine zoning district uses and regulations as well as obtaining building and sign permits at 513-661-2700 during the office hours of 9 am to noon on Saturdays and 7 pm to 9 pm on Wednesdays.
- 2. Meet with the Economic Development Director at Cheviot City Hall.
- 3. Meet with Fire Department at Cheviot City Hall to initiate process for Occupancy Permit.
- 4. Contact individual utility companies to set up inspections and/or accounts:

- Obtain vendor's license from Hamilton County Auditor (138 E. Court Street); call 946-4106.
  At federal level may need to file Form SS-4 Application for Employer Identification
  Number.
- 6. All businesses must register their names and legal structures (such as sole proprietorship, limited liability company, etc.) with the Ohio Secretary of State: 877-767-3453 or www.sos.state.oh.us.
- 7. Employers with one or more employees must carry workers' compensation coverage: 1-800-641-6292 or www.bwc.ohio.gov/Default.aspx
- 8. Contact Ohio Dept. of Taxation at (888) 405-4039 for Business Tax Assistance and 888-405-4089 for Tax Registration. Information is also online at <a href="www.obg.ohio.gov">www.obg.ohio.gov</a>. Existing Ohio businesses can simultaneously report and pay tax liabilities associated with Workers' Compensation, Unemployment Tax, Payroll Withholding Tax, and Sales Tax; for more information visit: <a href="www.ohiobusinessgateway.ohio.gov">www.ohiobusinessgateway.ohio.gov</a>
- 9. Contact Cheviot Tax Department to set up an account as there is a 2% earnings tax.
