NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Line item 208.101.239.3 of the First Quarter 2017 budget appropriations shall be increased to \$13,000.00.

<u>Section 2.</u> This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the City to continue providing canine services to the Police Department.
