And the City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw her warrants on the City Treasurer for payments from any of the foregoing appropriations upon receiving proper certifications and vouchers thereof, approved by the Board of Officers authorized by law to approve the same or any ordinance or resolution of Council to make the expenditures, provided that no warrants shall be drawn or paid for salaries or wages except for the persons employed by authority of and in accordance with law and ordinance. Provided further, that the Appropriations of Council for Contingencies can only be expended upon approval of a two-thirds majority of Council for the items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the City, and the purposes other than those covered by specific appropriations herein made.

<u>Section 26.</u> This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
