CITY OF CHEVIOT STATE OF OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 17 - 2

TO ENACT SECTION 131.145 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF CHEVIOT; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 131.145 of the Cheviot Code of Ordinances shall be enacted to read as follows:

§ 131.145 UNAUTHORIZED USE OF PARK FACILITIES

- (A) No person shall recklessly enter onto or remain on the premises of the Mayor's Pavilion at the Cheviot Fieldhouse.
- (B) Division (A) above shall not apply to:
 - persons and their invited guests who have, in advance of their use, rented the
 particular shelter by paying the applicable fee and deposit to the city recreation
 commissioner and having a rental permit issued for the period of time during which
 they are present;
 - 2) employees of the City of Cheviot while on official city business;
 - 3) independent contractors, under contract with the City of Cheviot, while on official city business.
- (C) Whoever violates division (A) of this section is guilty of unauthorized use of park facilities, a minor misdemeanor.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary for the peaceful enjoyment of the park and the protection of park property.
