**ORDINANCE NO. 19 - 21**

**TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 19-20; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, on June 18, 2019, this Council passed Ordinance No. 19-20, authorizing the submission of a 5.61 mill current expense levy to the Hamilton County Board of Elections; and

**WHEREAS**, the ordinance was not in the exact form required by the Board of Elections; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intention of this council to repeal Ordinance No. 19-20 and replace it with an ordinance meeting the Board's requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:**

Section 1. A copy of Ordinance No. 19-20, passed by this Council on June 18, 2019, is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as if fully rewritten herein.


Section 2. Ordinance No. 19-20 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. 




