ORDINANCE NO. 22-26

**TO INCREASE THE PAY RATE FOR PART-TIME FIRE EMPLOYEES, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance 15-13, this Council established certain wage rates, benefits, and working conditions for part-time employees of the Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance 19-17, this Council increased certain wage rates for said part-time employees; and

**WHEREAS**, this Council has determined that an hourly rate increase for part-time employees of the Fire Department is necessary to allow the City to remain competitive in its pay rates.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:**

Section 1. The wage rates of part-time employees of the Fire Department shall be as follows:


<u>Position/Qualification</u>	<u>Wage Rate</u>
Firefighter/EMT	\$16.50
Firefighter/Paramedic	\$20.00
Seniority 5-10 years	Additional \$0.50 per hour
Seniority 11-15 years	Additional \$0.50 per hour
Seniority over 15 years	Additional \$0.50 per hour
Firefighter/Paramedic/Engineer	Additional \$1.00 per hour
Certification Premium (Fire or EMS Instructor or Assistant, Fire Inspector, or Car Seat Technician	Additional \$0.25 - \$1.00 per hour

The Fire Chief may also decide, with the approval of the Safety-Service Director and the Mayor, to pay a part-time firefighter a premium of \$0.25 to \$1.00 per hour above his assigned rate where exceptional qualifications or experience warrant it, and where those skills are being used to benefit the City of Cheviot.

Section 2. The remaining portions of Ordinance 15-13, which address certain benefits, working conditions, and compensation on certain holidays shall remain in full force and effect. This Ordinance is intended only to increase the wage rates as set forth above in Section 1.

Section 3. The wage increases in this Ordinance shall be effective as of 10/14/22 and shall remain in effect unless modified by this Council.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the City's Fire Department to remain competitive in attracting and keeping the best qualified part-time employees.




