ORDINANCE NO. 22-14

TO INCREASE THE PAY RATE FOR CERTAIN CITY EMPLOYEES; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS this Council has determined that an hourly rate increase for certain City employees is necessary to allow the City to remain competitive in its pay rates.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1. The rates for part-time Maintenance Department employees shall be as follows:


<u>Position/Qualification</u>	<u>Wage Rate</u>
1 st Year Part-Time Garage/Maintenance	\$12.00/hour
2 nd Year Part-Time Garage/Maintenance	\$13.50/hour
3 rd Year Part-Time Garage/Maintenance	\$15.00/hour

Section 2. The wage increases in this Ordinance shall be effective May 1, 2022 and shall remain in effect unless modified by this Council.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the City to remain competitive in attracting and keeping the best qualified employees, as well as to update the pay rates for the upcoming pay periods.


