TO AMEND THE 2022 ANNUAL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to make adjustments to the appropriations of the 2022 annual budget by increasing a certain budget line item due to funds received from the state for police training.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF, CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1. The Budget Line Item 213.103.239.3 Cont. Prof. Training Contract Incidentals shall be increased by \$6,546.00.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the City to meet its financial obligations in a timely manner.




