ORDINANCE NO. 23-_____

TO ACCEPT THE BID OF J.K. MEURER FOR THE REPAVING OF HARVEST HOME PARK FAIRGROUNDS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2023, by Resolution 23-13, this Council authorized the Safety-Service Director to solicit bids for repaving of Harvest Home Park Fairgrounds; and

WHEREAS, in response to his advertisement, four such bids were submitted to the City; and

WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid was the base bid submitted by J.K. Meurer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

Section 1. This Council hereby accepts the base bid of \$139,981.86 submitted by J.K. Meurer for the repaving of Harvest Home Park Fairgrounds. The accepted bid shall be in accordance with the specifications on file in the office of the Safety-Service Director.

Section 2. In the event of unforeseen extra work which might be required, the Safety-Service Director shall not approve any such work which exceeds 10% of the project base cost without first receiving the authorization of this Council.

Section 3. The Safety-Service Director is authorized and directed to enter into the necessary contracts with J.K. Meurer in order to carry out the work covered by this bid.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to keep the City's property in the safest possible condition.
