Pahls, Treasurer, to the County Auditor, funds due in any settlement Of 2017 derived from taxes or other sources, payable to the County Treasurer to the account of the City of Cheviot, and lawfully applicable for purposes of the current fiscal year.

Upon passage of this Resolution, the Clerk of Council shall immediately forward a Section 2. certified copy of it to the Hamilton County Auditor.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately. Section 3.
