**RESOLUTION NO. 17 - 08**

**TO REJOIN AND BECOME A WE THRIVE COMMUNITY; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, a partnership with public health leverages and maximizes resources, tools, and provides subject matter experts that benefit the community; and

WHEREAS, engaging in Hamilton County Public Health's WeTHRIVE! initiative generates broad-based support for creating healthy environments where residents live, work, learn and play; and

WHEREAS, a healthy community is a strong, thriving community.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:**

Section 1. The City of Cheviot hereby recognizes the importance of public health efforts to prevent diseases, protect children, adults and families, and to promote healthy living principles to improve the overall health and vitality of City of Cheviot. In light of the foregoing considerations the City fully supports Hamilton County Public Health's WeTHRIVE! Initiative.


Section 2. The City of Cheviot will establish a WeTHRIVE! Team consisting of, at a minimum, a council member, a city administration member and two residents of the City of Cheviot. The WeTHRIVE! Team will be responsible for leading community health and wellness efforts and serving as a liaison between the City of Cheviot and Hamilton County Public Health.

Section 3. The City of Cheviot authorizes the WeTHRIVE! Team to select at least one Pathway and work through each Pathway's process with representatives from Hamilton County Public Health. The Cheviot WeTHRIVE! Team will collaborate with Hamilton County Public Health on an ongoing basis to work through additional Pathways, existing or newly established, to improve the overall health and well-being of our community.


Section 4. The City of Cheviot WeTHRIVE! Team shall designate a representative to participate in the WeTHRIVE! Community Learning Collaborative facilitated by Hamilton County Public Health.

Section 5. The Cheviot WeTHRIVE! Team shall report back to the Cheviot Council quarterly regarding steps taken to implement this Resolution, additional steps planned, and any desired actions that would need to be taken by City Council or other agencies or departments to implement the steps taken or planned.


Section 5. This resolution shall be an emergency measure for the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Cheviot and shall take effect immediately. The emergency is necessary in order to allow the city to apply for a WeTHRIVE! grant at the earliest possible time.




