**WHEREAS**, a copy of Resolution No. 19-04 is attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and made a part hereof as if fully rewritten herein; and



**WHEREAS**, because of the passage of Resolution No. 19-11, Resolution No. 19-04 is duplicative and unnecessary;


