RESOLUTION NO. 22-04

TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE CERTAIN LAW ENFORCEMENT ITEMS WITH MONIES FROM THE CRIMINAL ACTIVITY FORFEITURE FUND.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 2981.13(C)(2) and the Cheviot Police Department's Internal Control Policy, expenditures from the from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (also known as the Criminal Activity/Forfeiture Fund) may be made for law enforcement purposes that the legislative authority determines to be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Cheviot Police Department has requested that money, in an amount not to exceed \$9,500.00, be expended from the Fund to purchase the following items:

- 20 units – Electronic Ear Protection
- 100 units – Patrol Rifle Magazines
- 4 units – Taxer X26P
- 5 units – Taser Batteries
- 1 unit – Camcorder; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that the expenditure is an appropriate use of money in the Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The expenditure of up to \$9,500.00 for the purchase the following items from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (also known as the Criminal Activity/Forfeiture Fund) is hereby approved:

- 20 units – Electronic Ear Protection
- 100 units – Patrol Rifle Magazines
- 4 units – Taxer X26P
- 5 units – Taser Batteries
- 1 unit – Camcorder


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
