RESOLUTION NO. 22-12

TO APPROVE CONTRACT WITH THE AMERICAN FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY, AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES LABOR UNION FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING AUGUST 1, 2022 AND ENDING JULY 31, 2025.

WHEREAS, the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) is the recognized bargaining unit of the full-time employees of the City of Cheviot Public Works Department; and;

WHEREAS, the current labor contract between the City and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees expires on July 31, 2022; and


WHEREAS, prior to the expiration of the current contract, the labor union and the City have been in negotiations to enter into a new three-year agreement; and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been reached between the Mayor of the City of Cheviot and the representatives of the labor union, and the contract is now being presented to the governing bodies of each party for approval.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

Section 1. The collective bargaining agreement between the City of Cheviot and the American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees for the period beginning August 1, 2022 and ending July 31, 2025, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof, is hereby approved.


Section 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately.


