Re: Police Department Activity Report

During the 3rd quarter of 2017, our Police Department activity included:

Our department received 1460 calls for service in the 3rd quarter from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 361 self/officer-generated details for a total of 1821 responses for service. This number does not include dozens of calls which come into the station or citizens walking into the station requesting police services.

• Ten (10) subjects arrested on Felony charges, including:

- o Person with a gun
- o Felonious Assault
- o Drug Arrest
- o Fraud/Theft

• Eighty- Five (85) Misdemeanor arrests, which included:

- o Multiple arrests for drug abuse and related charges
- o Arrests for Domestic Violence
- o Trespassing charges

• One Hundred Eighteen (118) Traffic charges, including:

- o Driving Under Suspension
- o Speeding
- Six (6) arrested for OVI.
- Fifty-Four (54) arrests of subjects who had outstanding warrants from other Jurisdictions, including 5 Felony warrants.
- Fifty-Four (54) FTO arrests (failures to appear at Cheviot Magistrate Court)
