



2017 Statistics

In 2017 the Cheviot Fire Division responded to 403 fire runs. The total fire loss was estimated to be \$42,377.00

The Cheviot Division of EMS responded to 1,508 emergency medical calls. Revenue generated from EMS billing for 2017 was \$213,319.44

The Cheviot Training Division logged over 1080 hours of training that included joint operations with local area departments.



The city hired Engineer Tyler Richter in March as our newest full time employee. Tyler started with the Fire Department in 2015 as a part time firefighter and has been a great addition to the department.



The Cheviot Fire Prevention and Education Division conducted 222 fire Inspections, installed 88 car seats, held 44 prevention activities and issued 12 business permits.
