Re: Annual Police Department Activity Report

During the year of 2017, our Police Department activity included but was not limited to the following;

We received 5122 calls for service in the calendar year 2017 from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 1430 self-generated and assist The Cheviot Fire Department for a total of 6552 requests for service. This number does not include 100s of calls which come into the station or citizens walking into the station requesting police services. Cheviot Officers logged 13,682 entries in our Pamet Data- Base for the calendar year 2017. These entries include dispatched details, walk ins, self-generated details, completed patrol directives and extra-jobs assigned to an officer which he executes during his shift.

- **Twenty-Two (22) subjects arrested on Felony charges, including:**
 - Person with a gun
 - Felonious Assault
 - Drug Arrest
 - Fraud/Theft
- **Four Hundred Sixty (460) Misdemeanor arrests, which included:**
 - Multiple arrests for drug abuse and related charges
 - Arrests for Domestic Violence
 - Trespassing charges
 - County / Cheviot FTO Warrants

Five Hundred Sixty (560) Traffic charges, including:

- Driving Under Suspension
- Speeding
- Lane Violations
- Yield Violations
- OVI arrests
- Etc

Additional Notes;

*Cheviot Officers made Two Hundred Ninety-Seven requests for Assist from other departments

*Cheviot's K9 was deployed 44 times in the last 7 months of the year. K9 Kuno and his Handler were participating in training the first portion of the year.

*In September, we re-instituted our lock out program. As of today's, date we have assisted 26 individuals in gaining access into their locked vehicle.

*In mid-summer, the Cheviot Police department participated in the Hamilton County Heroin Coalition program. This consisted of a separate report submitted so information may be gathered and presented to Ohio State Legislature in solving our drug epidemic.

Two part time officers were hired by our department this year. Two officers were promoted to a fulltime vacancy. Two patrolman were promoted to sergeant. One patrolman was moved into an Investigator position.

Training:

- * All Officers completed OPOTA minimum 20 hrs CPT required for 2017
- * All Officers completed the required (and beyond) firearms training required by OPOTA
- * All officers completed Taser requalification program
