Re: Police Department Activity Report

During the 1st quarter of 2019, The Cheviot Police Department activity included:

Our department received 1181 calls for service in the 1st quarter from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 627 self / non billed details for a total of 1808 responses for service. Officers made a total of 3620 entries, for the first quarter, into our Pamet reporting system. These additional entries represent extra assignments, building checks, vacation checks, business checks, directed patrol, warrant service etc.

### Correspondence(s) received:



Sgt. Patton and P.O. Reinshagen received a letter of commendation from Fire Chief Klein for their efforts involving a medical emergency and starting CPR.



### Training:


 All officers continued in-service training through eOPOTA. All officers trained on GRTP's situational FATS firearms training simulator.
