During the 1st quarter of 2019, The Cheviot Police Department activity included:

Our department received 1181 calls for service in the 1st quarter from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 627 self / non billed details for a total of 1808 responses for service. Officers made a total of 3620 entries, for the first quarter, into our Pamet reporting system. These additional entries represent extra assignments, building checks, vacation checks, business checks, directed patrol, warrant service etc.

Training:

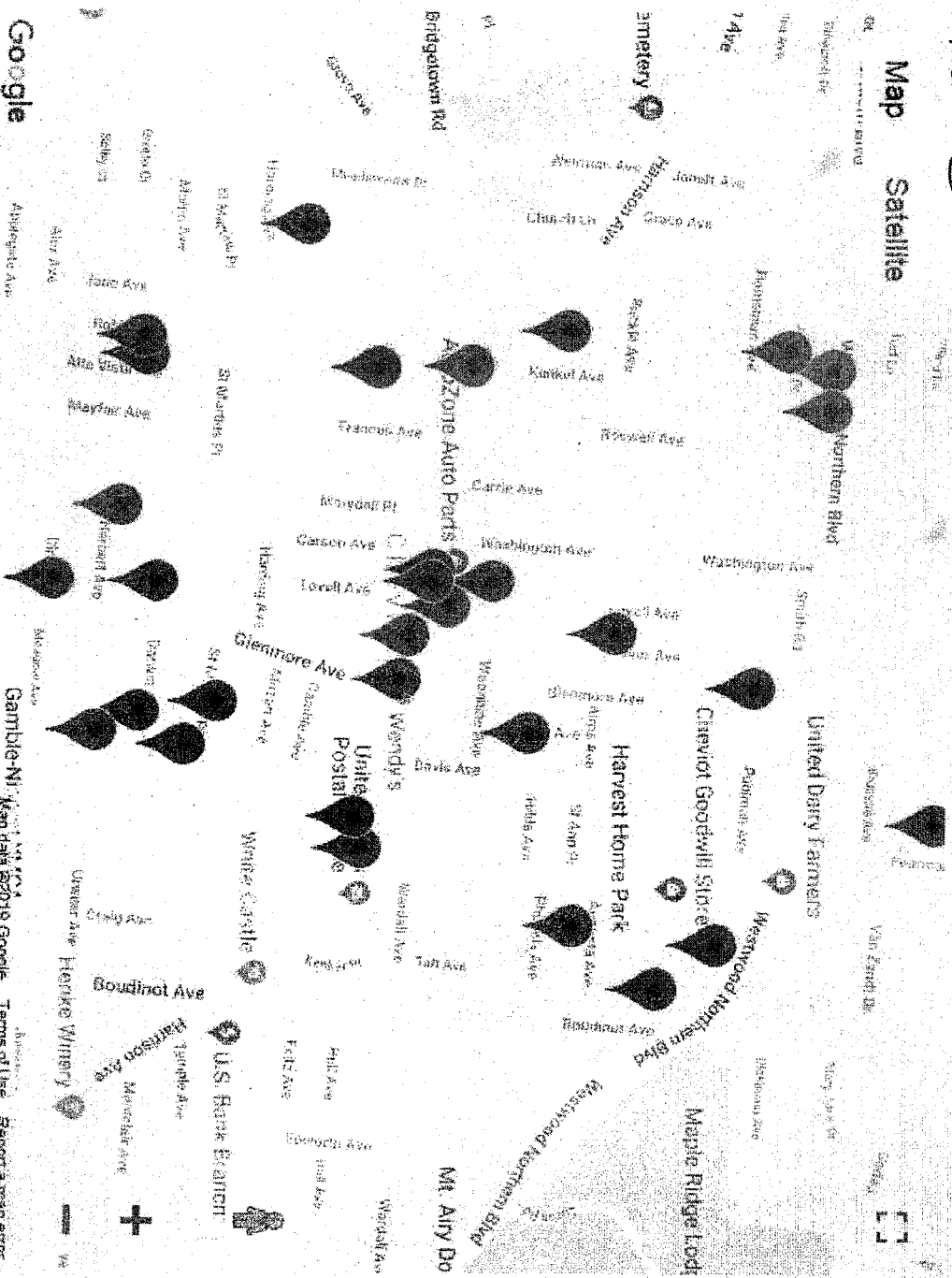
- All officers continued in-service training through eOPOTA. All officers trained on GRTP's situational FATS firearms training simulator.

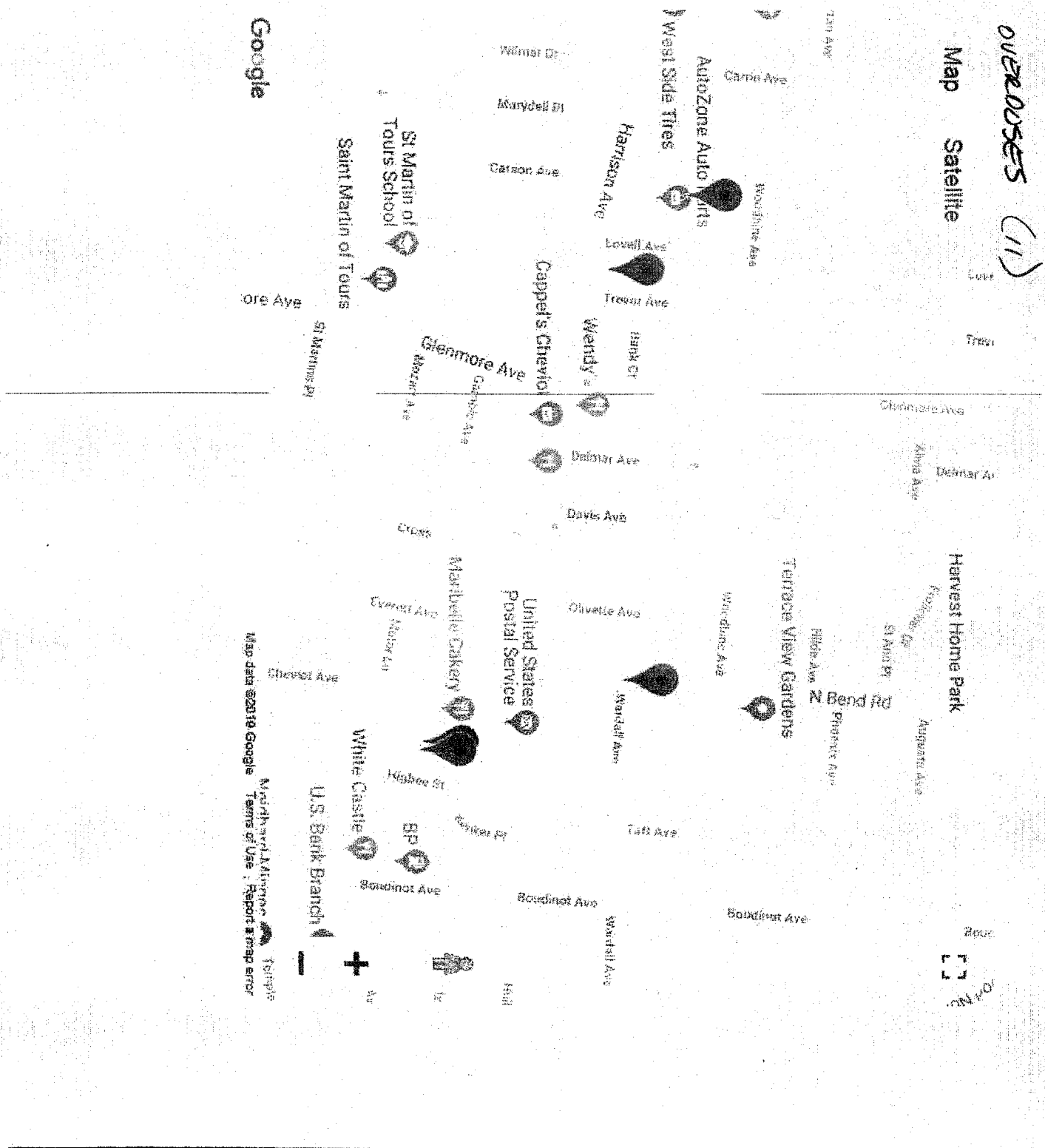

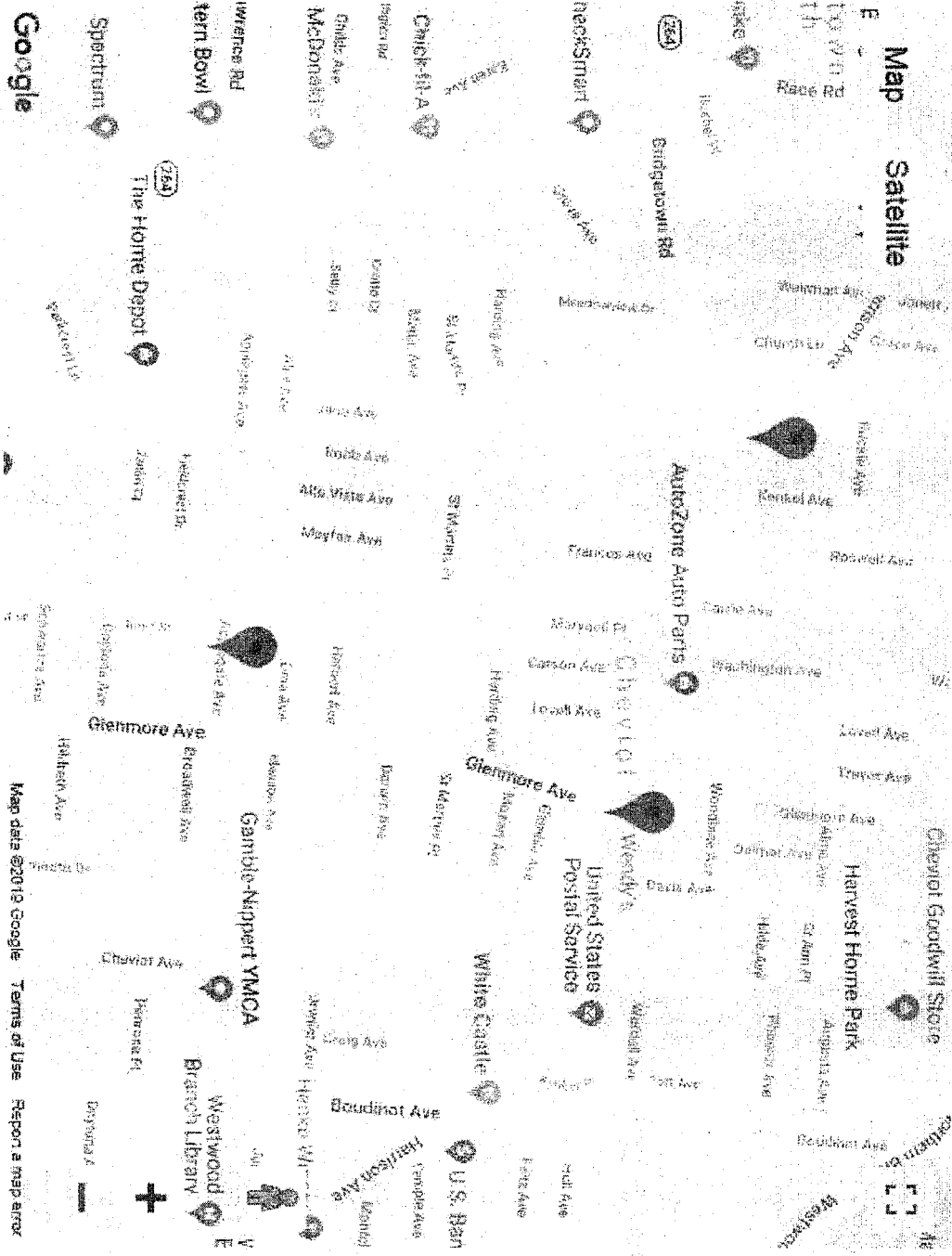

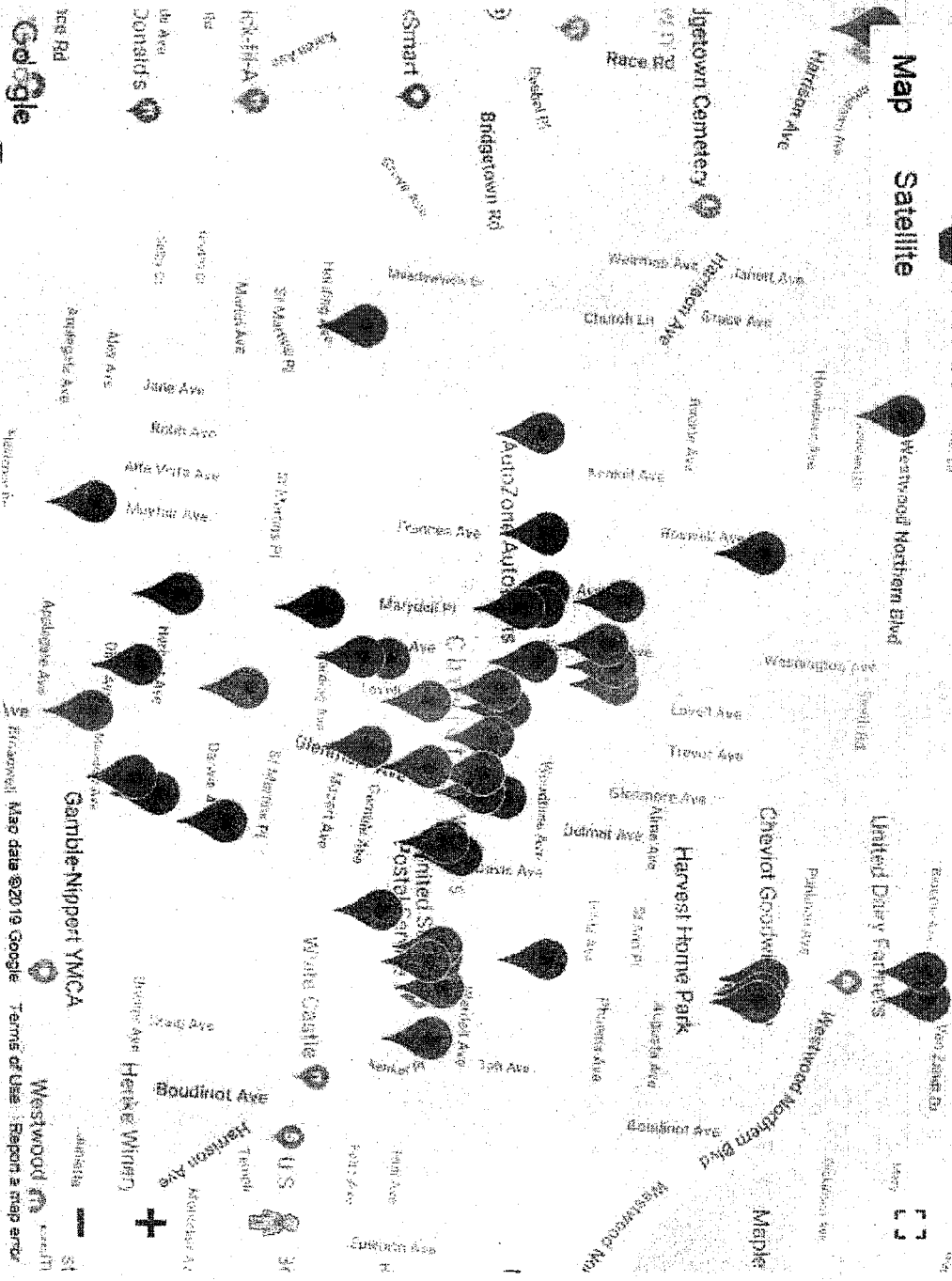
