During the 3rd quarter of 2019, The Cheviot Police Department activity included:

Our department received 1381 calls for service in the 3rd quarter from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 644 self / non billed details for a total of 2025 responses for service. Officers made a total of 3948 entries, for the third quarter, into our Pamet reporting system. These additional entries represent extra assignments, building checks, vacation checks, business checks, directed patrol, warrant service etc.

Crime Alert has been activated and is now in use.

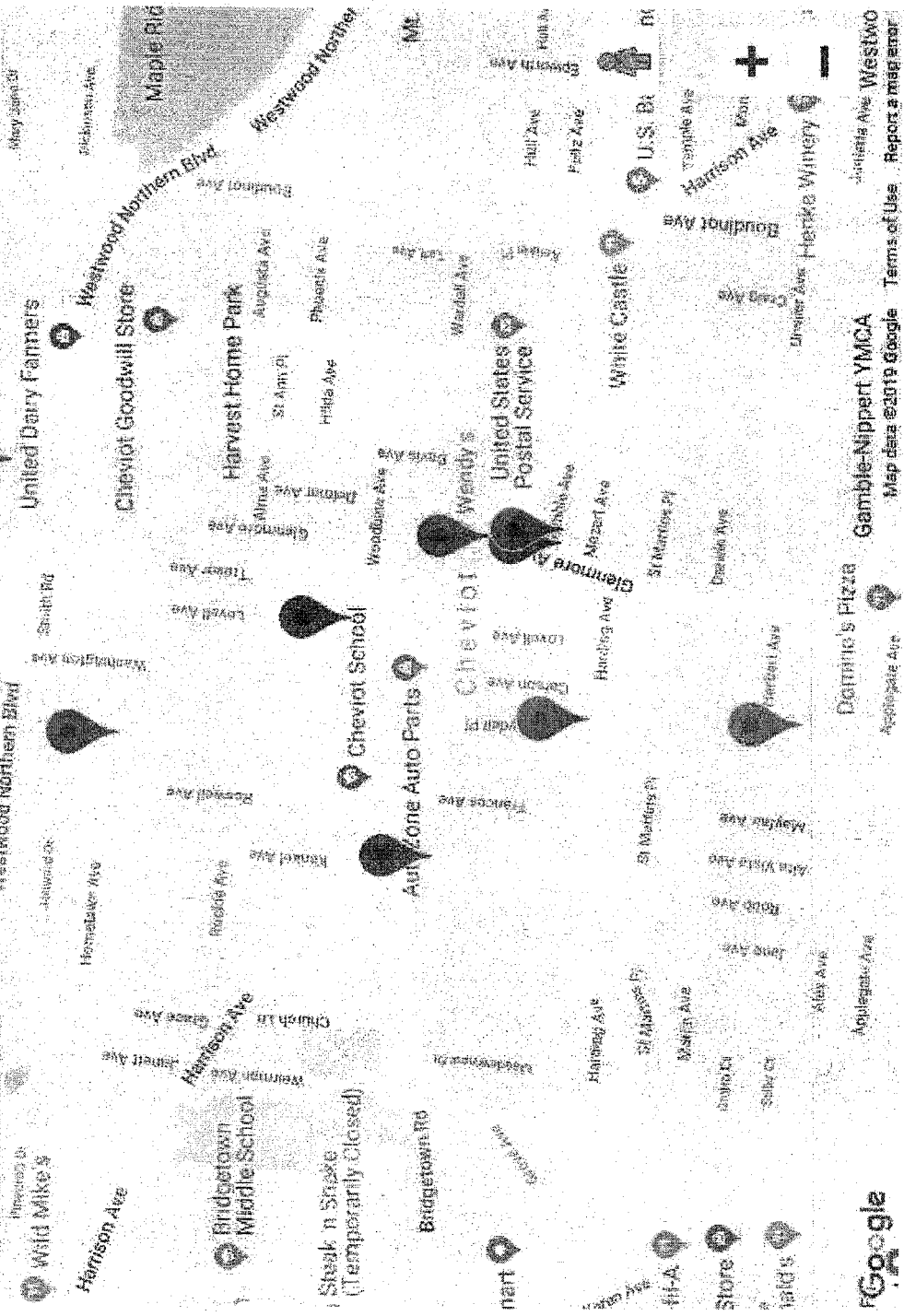

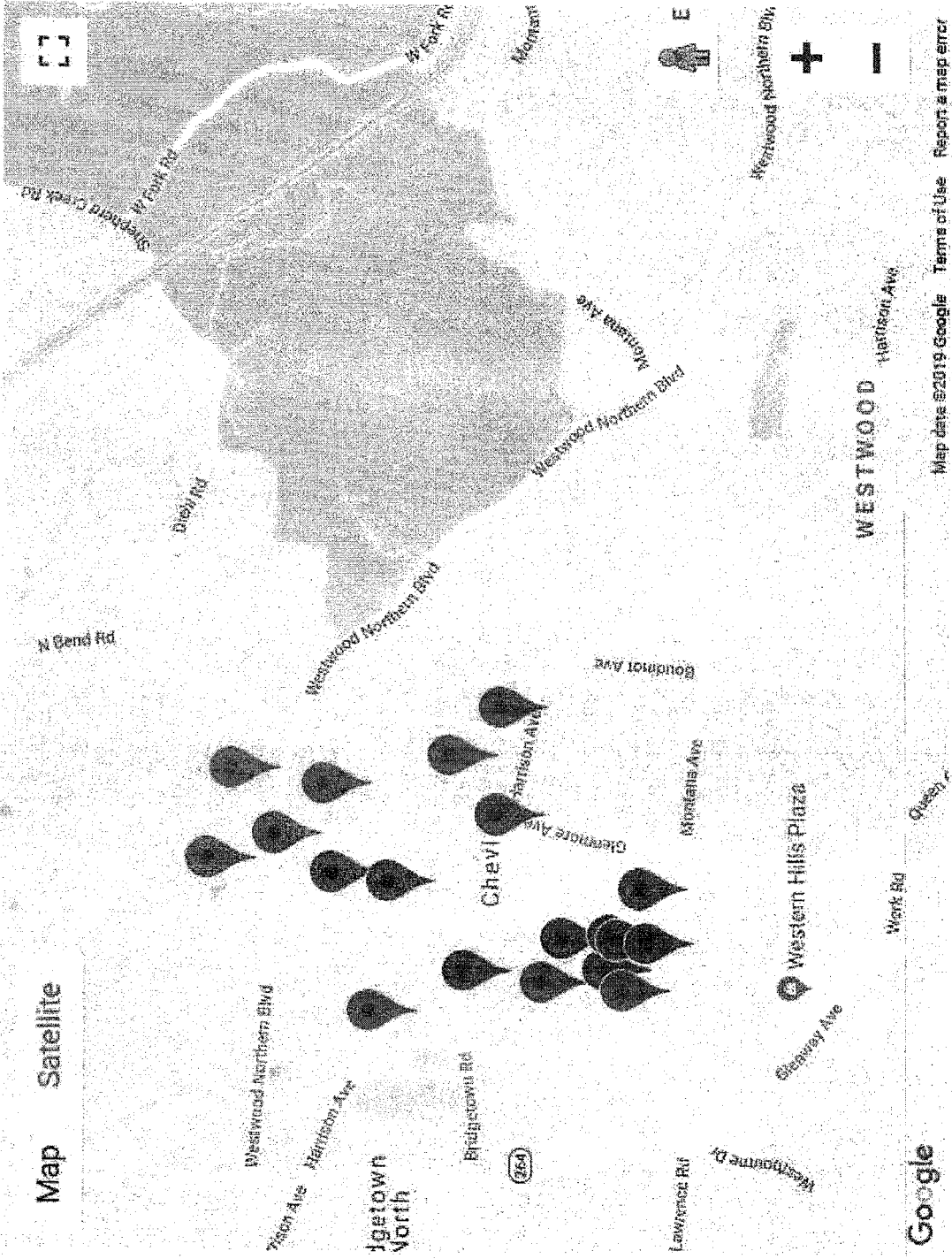
