**Division of Fire Report**  
**2020 Quarterly Report 7/7/20**

Mayor Keller,

As of July 1st. the Fire Department responded to 175 Fire Runs and 772 Squad runs. Our Fire Inspectors have completed 33 fire inspections and participated in 5 fire prevention actives. The department installed 11 car seats and trained over 318 hours in fire and EMS.

The Fire Department has had great success in obtaining PPE to this point; fire inspections, tours, PR events, and car seats have been put on hold due to the pandemic. Strict PPE rules are in effect and major decontamination of all vehicles, equipment, and the station was implemented with 100% compliance. Temperatures are being done before and after every shift. We are limiting contact with all other city personnel and citizens.

The city has 43 active Covid19 cases and an additional ten patents have been cleared, 21 of those are at one nursing home. In April we had 5 positive cases, in May we had 13 positive cases, in June we had 26 positive cases, and July to date 9 cases. The department has only transported 5 of those cases.

The Fire Department issued 1 new business permits this year.

The Fire Department maintains most of our own vehicles and equipment. Weekly checks are done on all vehicles, breathing apparatus, saws, smoke ejectors, and extrication equipment. Daily checks are done on both squads, and fire apparatus. The personnel clean and disinfect the firehouse daily. The fire department also maintains the fuel log for city hall and measures the fuel levels daily.
