2020 Statistics



The city lost an icon in 2020. Marlene Steers was the first female E.M.T. Fire Fighter for the City of Cheviot. She served faithfully from 1976 to 1998.



In 2020 the Cheviot Fire Division responded to 386 fire runs. The total fire loss was estimated to be \$46,300.00

The Cheviot Division of EMS responded to 1,618 emergency medical calls. Revenue generated from EMS billing for 2020 was \$227,017.50 plus an additional \$6,418.16 in Medicare Money. Total of \$233,435.66

The Cheviot Training Division logged over 170 hours of training that included joint operations



The City was able to purchase a new 2020 F450 4x4 ambulance out of Covid Relief Funds replacing a 2006 ambulance. The cost was \$198,945.00.

The Cheviot Fire Prevention and Education Division conducted 45 fire inspections, installed 27 car seats, held 5 prevention activities and issued 3 business permits. Covid Precautions were in effect.
