TOPIC: FINAL DRAFT OF ORD 20-22 – DORA

Research was presented on questions and suggested additions to the Ord.

As a result, it was decided that items "a" and "b" will be included in Ord. 20-22

- a. Cheviot Dora will be reviewed by Council in One Year to determine if it should continue, be modified or dissolved.
- b. Wording will be added to Section 5 to allow adjustment of hours of operation to accommodate State or local orders ord. or laws restricting hours of operation for bars and restaurants. (Covid)

Rules for Street Events and/or Festivals need not be included in Ord, rather Council will give authority to SSD to set Rules to limit and/or adjust DORA for each Event. Rules and Regulations, along with a Q. and A. Sheet about the DORA will be posted on City Web Site.

The number of personnel needed to insure Public Safety during DORA hours is already covered in Section 6 of Ord 20-22, referencing Section "F" of Cheviot Application to be forwarded to the State.

Extending Boundaries of Dora can be addressed by amendment in the future, if the need arises.

Westside Market Participants do not qualify to be a part of Cheviot's DORA – (Participants must be a local Cheviot brick and mortar business with proper liquor license.)

This Information has been forwarded to the Law Director so that she might prepare the final draft of Ord 20-22. A hard copy will be available to all of Council at the Oct. 6<sup>th</sup> Council meeting.

It is the recommendation of the Committee that the adjusted Ord. Draft be presented to Council for a final reading and vote at the Oct 6, Council Meeting. Meeting adjourned at 7:35 PM
