- PBIS going through the results of TFI to set goals in areas of focus

- Reading - K-3 wrapping up Winter testing and starting mid-year testing for MAP and Dibels; AIR test in 3rd grade - 29% proficient so far - going through the data and forming strategies to bring all students to proficient
