Re: First Quarter 2021

During the first quarter of 2021, The Cheviot Police Department received 1197 calls for service from the Hamilton County Communications Center. Not included in that number were 616 self-initiated/non-billed details for a total of 1813 dispatcher related responses for service. Officers logged a total of 4307 entries for the first quarter or 2021 into our Sundance reporting system. These additional entries represent extra jobs, building checks, vacation checks, business checks, self- initiated details, details called into the station, directed patrols etc.
