WHEREAS, the WeTHRIVE! initiative encourages long-lasting change through creation and adoption of policies that support the health, safety and vitality of the community; and



WHEREAS, the City of Cheviot has assumed an active leadership role in improving the health and safety of its community members as a WeTHRIVE! Community.


