Councilman David Voss- reported that he asked about the rate Westside Market was charged in the past and was advised and provided with a copy of the rental agreement for one dollar.

Councilman Brian Smyth reported that he had spoken with Mrs. Krystal Gaiser about the Market and he reported that the Market will be moving due to issues regarding renting Harvest Home Park vs the parking lot on Harrison Ave. Mrs. Gaiser and the Mayor had a difference of opinion.

There was discussion about previous rates- for market \$200.00 initially for parking lot and then \$350.00 donation to Cheviot Business Alliance, this past year.


Council was not aware of these rates and were not informed of these rates when – increasing the rental rate of Harvest Home Park.


All Council Members agreed that they would like Westside Market to remain in Cheviot.


