Proposals regarding the property known as 3625 Harrison Ave formed the basis for our discussions which included the following:

- The committee recognized the viability and has indicated strong support for the Greater Cincinnati Police Museum proposal put forth by the Cincinnati Police Historical Society.
- After touring the current Police Museum and reviewing the various documents provided by the Cincinnati Police Historical society including renderings, budget information, prospectus and other information the committee generally agrees that the Museum would be an acceptable project to consider and wishes to cooperate with the CPHS in determining the feasibility of relocating the Museum to Cheviot.






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
