Minutes of City Council, Cheviot, Ohio

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Meeting was called to order at 7:43 by President Slaughter with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer. The following were found to be in attendance:

A motion was made by Mr. Clark to excuse the absences of Mrs. Roden and Mr. Sunderhaus. Motion was seconded by Mr. Dinkelacker, and carried with a 5-0 voice vote.

Minutes from the July 21 meeting were approved with a motion by Mrs. Richter, second by Mr. Dinkelacker and a 5-0 voice vote.

Ordinance 15-21 To Enact Chapter 114 Of The Cheviot Code of Ordinances (Food Trucks). Motion to introduce made by Mrs. Richter, seconded by Mr. Dinkelacker. Motion carried with a 5-0 voice vote. This constitutes the first reading.

Ordinance 15-22 To Transfer Funds; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to remove Section 4, pertaining to the payment of recycling fees was made by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Clark. Section 5 will now be called Section 4 on the legislation. Public Works committee to meet on 8/25 to further discuss recycling and the fees thereof. Motion to introduce Ordinance 15-22 was made by Mr. Dinkelacker, second by Mrs. Richter, carried with 5-0 voice vote. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mrs. Zech, second by Mrs. Richter, carried with 5-0 roll call vote. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Clark, second by Mr. Dinkelacker, carried with 5-0 roll call vote.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller informed council that some changes will be forthcoming in the manner in which park rentals are conducted. Recycling bins will be removed from the area on Camvic Terrace because they're being used as trash receptacles. Additional bins will be placed at Robb Ave.

Law Director's Report: Mr. Waters notes that FOP mitigation hearing will be held next week. He may seek council's approval to seek outside help with the Morebattle title. Moving forward with Mayor's Court fee increase.

Other Business: Mr. Martin gave a rundown of the recent LSDMC meeting at Cheviot School. He is impressed with the good things going on at the school and encourages all of council to volunteer their time when possible and to join the PTA. Sept 21, Cheviot School will host the Soccer Invitational at the fieldhouse.

Treasurer's Receipts: Mrs. Zech motioned to receive and file the report from June 2015. Second by Mrs. Richter.

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Mayor's Court Receipts: Mrs. Zech motioned to receive and file the report from July 2015. Second by Mr. Martin.

Correspondence: Harvest Home Fair Kickoff Luncheon, Wednesday, Sept. 9 at noon.




