PublicRecognition: Cheviot Fire Department Captain, Larry Cole addressed council to thank the City of Cheviot for all of the opportunities afforded to him during his 39 year tenure. Captain Cole is retiring this spring and will continue his service on a part time basis in the Building Department.

Mrs. Tucker read into record her report from the Municipal Properties meeting held on January 10. She motioned to receive and file the report. The motion received a second from Mr. Tiettmeyer and was carried with a 6-0 voice vote.

Ordinance 17-03 To Set The Pre-Season Pass Rates For The Cheviot Municipal Swimming Pool For The 2017 Season; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce was made by Mrs. Tucker, second by Mr. Sunderhaus. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mr. Martin. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Dinkelacker, second by Mr. Martin. Motions carried with unanimous votes.

There were reports from the 2nd and 3rd quarters from Police Chief Lally and summary of activity within the Fire Department from Fire Chief Klein. Both reports are on file at city hall. Contact the Clerk of Council if you'd like to view them.

Safety Services Director: Mr. Braun that some of the forfeited funds be moved to the K9 Replacement Fund. The new dog, along with training, will require \$13,000. Mr. Braun will be meeting with the Haverkamp Foundation to see if part of the funds can come from them. Also, Mr. Braun is attending a meeting next week to discuss the Westwood Northern road project.
