Resolution 17-11 To Approve the 2018 Tax Budget. Motion to introduce made by Mr. Martin, second by Mr. Tiettmeyer. Resolution passed with unanimous voice vote.

Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller asked for continued prayers for Rich Fenster. Brews on the Block will be held Sept. 29, 30 and Oct 1. Security and safety issues were discussed at a meeting last week.

Safety-Services Director: Mr. Braun reported that gas aggregation opt-out letters have been mailed. Ruth, Ruckle and Washington road projects will begin in a couple of weeks. Westwood Northern Blvd will go out for bid on August 28. The City has written 90 notices for tall grass.

Public Recognition: No one addressed council on any non-agenda issues. John Snape advised that his wife has agreed to paint some of the sheep to help with the backlog.


Treasurer's Report from May 2017 was received and filed with a motion by Mrs. Tucker and a second by Mrs. Zech and a 7-0 voice vote.
