While no change will be made in the one for Family Dollar, since Mainsource Bank will become First Financial effective April 2, three separate resolutions will be prepared: one for Family Dollar's renewal, one for the name change for the bank, and the third to extend the CRA under the bank's new name.

Law Director's Report: Mrs. Rohr reports that the case filed against the State of Ohio (HB 49) has been dismissed in the district court. An appeal has been filed, and Mrs. Rohr will keep council updated.
