

Public Hearing, August 20, 2019 7:00PM

The hearing was called to order at 7:05PM by Mark Waters, President of Council. The purpose of the hearing was to give attention to public comments regarding the proposed Overlay Zoning District For A Portion Of The Business "B" District.

Present in council chambers were council members, Safety Service Director Tom Braun and residents Kerry Smyth, Debbie Slaughter and John Hardig.

Mr. Braun presented a map of the proposed Overlay District which spans an area along Harrison Avenue. The purpose of establishing an overlay district is to promote development that emphasizes existing neighborhood business district character, to promote re-development in a coordinated manner and to provide long-term sustainability of the business district. The legislation covers particulars such as setbacks, parking, aesthetics.

Mrs. Zech read the bullet points which had been discussed in the zoning committee meeting. Mrs. Slaughter noted that no potential or existing businesses had made any inquiries regarding the overlay. .

Mr. Waters closed the hearing at 7:26PM.
