Motion to approve the minutes from the September 22 special council meeting were approved by a 6-0 council vote.

The purpose of this meeting was for discussion and passage of Ordinance 20-23 To Authorize The Safety-Service Director To Enter Into A Contract To Purchase A 2020 Ford F-450 4X4 Ambulance; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce the ordinance was made by Mr. Voss, second by Mrs. Zech. Motion to suspend the rules was made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Hardig. Much discussion ensued, the gist of that centering around the fact that the purchase that was not budgeted for the year, and the funds to pay for the ambulance have not yet been approved at the state level. The verbiage of the Ordinance 20-23 was altered to include the following: "The authority to purchase of ambulance is conditioned upon the approval of the State of Ohio for the use of CARES Act funding for such a purchase". Mr. Voss then motioned for adoption, seconded by Mrs. Richter. The motion carried with a 6-0 roll call vote.

Seeing no further business before this Council, Mr. Voss motioned for adjournment. Mrs. Zech seconded and the meeting adjourned at 7:40.
