Motion to introduce made by Mrs. Tucker, second by Mr. Voss. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Tucker. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mr. Voss. All motions carried unanimously.

**Ordinance 20-07** To Set The Daily Rates For Admission To The Cheviot Municipal Swimming Pool; And To Declare An Emergency. Motion to introduce made by Mrs. Tucker, second by Mrs. Zech. Motion to suspend the rules made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Tucker. Motion to adopt made by Mr. Sunderhaus, second by Mrs. Hardig. All motions carried unanimously.

-Mr. Voss called a meeting of the Finance Committee for Tuesday, February 25, 7pm to discuss appropriations


-Family Day Planning Committee will meet on Thursday, May 5, at 7pm in the committee room.
