Council President Waters called the meeting to order at 7:38PM with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer.

Committee Reports:

Mr Voss read into record his report from the Finance Committee meeting of 2-25-2020. He motioned to receive and file, second was by Mrs. Tucker and unanimous council approval.

Ms. Griffin read into record her report from the Internal/External Affairs Committee meeting of 2-11-2020. It was received and filed with a motion by Ms. Griffin, a second by Mrs. Richter and a 6-0 voice vote.

Legislation:

Ordinance 20-05 To Accept the Annexation of 2.5 Acres From Green Township, Hamilton County, Ohio To The City Of Cheviot. Read by title, and with brief description by Mrs. Hardig. There was no discussion. This constitutes the second reading.

Resolution 20-03 To Accept The One Ohio Memorandum Of Understanding Regarding The Pursuit And Use Of Potential Opioid Litigation Settlement Funds; And To Declare An Emergency. Introduced by Mrs. Zech, second by Ms. Griffin, and unanimous council voice vote. There was no discussion. Motion to adopt was made by Mrs. Tucker, second by Mrs. Richter and unanimous voice vote.

Administrative Reports:


- Mayor's Report: Mayor Keller addressed the importance of having full participation in the 2020 Census. The results of the Census should provide an accurate account of Cheviot residents. These figures translate into the amount of aid the city receives from state and federal funds. Mrs. Richter asked if we could partner with the library to see if their staff could be available to assist some residents with answering the questions online. She will contact Eric Pennington at the library. Mayor Keller also publicly thanked Mr. Braun for all of his efforts to secure grant money for city projects. For the Alma, Davis & Delmar project, just over \$1M in grant money was received.
- Safety Service Director: The St. Martins-North Bend Road pre-construction meeting was held. Tentative start date is June 1. Water main replacement will begin this week. TAP (Technical Assistance Program) review meeting will be held on April 14 at 6:30PM. All members of council and the clerk should attend
- Law Director: Mrs. Rohr was not present.


