Mayor's Report

Mayor Keller reported that there was an incident on Washington Avenue on August 12 in which the Fire Department had to call in the S.W.A.T. team. Mayor Keller sent a letter thanking the Cheviot Police and Fire Departments, the Hamilton County S.W.A.T. team, the Police Departments of Harrison, Fairfax, Golf Manor, and Green Township, along with the Hamilton County Sheriff's Department for their assistance with the stand off.

Committee Reports

Ward 1 - Mr. Murray had no formal report. He did remind the public that the final C.A.P. movie in the park would be at the Harvest Home Barn at dusk (approx. 8:00 P.M.) on Friday, August 20. He also wanted to thank Jo Ann for running the crafts in the park program on Tuesdays and Thursdays through the summer. Mr. Murray mentioned Metro will go through with changes even after Cheviot passed a Resolution opposing the change. There was much discussion about the specific changes to the bus routes. Mr. Murray reminded the public that Sunday, August 22 was the last day that the Harvest Home Pool was open. Mayor Keller reminded Council that the 31st Cheviot Employee Picnic was on Tuesday, September 31. Mayor Keller also informed Council that Michele Smith has given 3 weeks notice after 17 years of service to the City of Cheviot. She will be replaced by Teresa Sunderhaus.

Ward 2 - Mr. Dinkelacker had no formal report.

Ward 3 - Mr. Sunderhaus had no formal report. He did read a letter from the Public Library in Cheviot thanking the Cheviot Police and Fire Departments for attending Hero's Day. Mayor Keller requested that the letter be forwarded to the Police and Fire Departments.

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Ward 4 - Mrs. Gooch had no formal report. Mrs. Gooch made a motion *To Submit To The Hamilton County Board Of Elections A Proposed Replacement Tax Levy To Be Voted Upon By The Electors Of The City Of Cheviot At The Next General Election; And To Declare An Emergency.* Mr. Sunderhaus made a second. The motion carried 7-0 by voice vote and was assigned as RES04-14.

Council at Large - Mrs. Zech had no formal report. She did call for a meeting of the Laws, Rules, and Ordinances Committee to meet with the Building Department on Wednesday, August 25 at 7 P.M. at Cheviot City Hall to discuss Housing Codes. She wished her husband Charles a happy birthday.

Council at Large - Mr. Norman had no formal report.

Mr. Mestemaker made a motion to receive and file the Treasurer's Report for June, 2004. Mr. Murray made the second. The motion carried 7-0 by voice vote.
