

CIVIL SERVICE EXAM FOR FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC
CITY OF CHEVIOT

Date & Time: Saturday, January 8th, 2022, at 9am
Place: Cheviot Fieldhouse, 3723 Robb Avenue
Age: At least 18 years of age
Requirements: High School Diploma or GED Certificate
Current Ohio Paramedic Certified
Ohio Firefighter II Certified

An open competitive Civil Service Examination to establish an eligibility list for the City of Cheviot Fire Department will be held as stated above. The exam will start promptly at 9am. Doors will be closed and no one will be granted admittance after 9am. Current Ohio Paramedic card and current Ohio Firefighter II certifications are required for candidates to take the exam. The test will consist of a written exam on general knowledge and an oral interview. The written test will carry a weight of 80%, the oral 20%. Written test must be passed with a test score of at least 70% prior to taking the oral exam.

After receiving a total passing grade of 70% or higher the applicant will receive an additional (5) points for military credit upon proof of service time. Applicant must produce a DD-214 at the time of submitting application to receive credit.

Starting salary for the firefighter/paramedic position is \$59,590.09 for the first year. Benefits include a shared cost hospitalization major medical health plan, ten paid holidays, sick days, and a liberal vacation plan.

Applications will be available at Cheviot City Hall, 3814 Harrison Avenue, Monday through Friday, 8:15am to 3:45pm on the 2nd floor, Administrative Office. Applications will be accepted starting Monday, November 29, 2021, through Friday, December 31, 2021. Please see Sarah Kastner for applications. There is a \$15 administrative fee charged for each application. Proof of education, any military service, and/or any fire, or paramedic certifications must be attached. .
