How Does it Work?

No need to sign up! Just add a few small steps to your routine!

1 FILL UP WITH HARD-TO-RECYCLE PLASTICS
Fill the Hefty Storage Bag with acceptable hard-to-recycle plastics.

2 DROP IN WITH REGULAR RECYCLING
Tie up the full orange bag and place it in your outside recycling cart or at an approved drop-off location, along with normal recyclables.

3 RENEW INTO VALUABLE RESOURCES
The orange bags are sorted at your local recycling center and acceptable contents are sent to a facility to be converted into valuable resources.
*Market of valuable resources may vary by geography.
