President Kerry Smyth called the meeting to order at 7:30PM with the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silent prayer.

Mr. Hardig motioned to excuse Ms. Hawk. Motion was seconded by Mrs. Richter and carried 6-0.

Minutes from the November 1 meeting were approved with a motion by Mrs. Zech, seconded by Mr. B. Smyth, and carried 6-0.

Mr. Hardig read his report of the Zoning Committee meeting held on November 1. Mr. Voss added that the Cincinnati Police Museum has shown significant interest in using the space inside the former Cappel's building for their new location. They have offered all committee members and others an after-hours tour of their current facility. The date November 29 at 7:30 was set aside. Mr. Voss will confirm that this date and time is convenient for the museum. It is suggested that carpooling is arranged due to tight parking at the museum in downtown Cincinnati. Mr. Harding motioned to receive and file his report, there was a second by Mr. B. Smyth, and the motion carried unanimously. Mrs. Rohr noted that during this outing, there must be no discussion among council members as to any future plans regarding the museum or any other council business.

Legislation: No legislation is being presented tonight.

Administrative Reports:

Mayor Keller reported that electrical service is nearly complete at Harvest Home Lodge. had no report. Adleta is currently doing curbwork on Alta Vista Mayfair and Herbert Aves. The community nativity will be dedicated on ~~Saturday~~ November 26 at 6:30PM. Tony & Roberta Michel will be flipping the switch. **Law Director Rohr** added that the Nativity is not sponsored by the City. Cheviot Community Foundation owns the statues and Auto Zone graciously donates their property to display it each year. Sunshine Law training, which needs to be completed by each elected official prior to the end of their term, is being offered virtually on November 17 1-4:15PM and in person in West Chester in March 2023.


Other Business: Mayor Keller advised that the City will allow its Zoom license to expire since the functions are offered in the new email server's Groups platform.
