**Legislation:**

Motion to suspend the rules was made by Mr. Smyth, second by Mr. Voss. Motion to adopt was made by Mrs. Zech, second by Mrs. Richter. All motions carried unanimously.

**Administrative Reports:**

Mayor Keller wished all of Council and those in the room a Merry Christmas. He also stated that the Marathon station will be opening January 31. It is unknown at this time what the operating hours will be and what kind of food will be offered. Also, the Harvest Home Lodge renovation project is complete except for punch list items. No feedback has been received regarding the Cincinnati Police Museum.

**Safety Service Director Braun** had no report since the mayor already reported about the Marathon station.

**Law Director** The FOP arbitration is completed. Interpretation of the contract terms regarding use of sick time was the issue. Mrs. Rohr thanked Police Chief Stone, Councilmember Voss, SSD Braun and Mayor Keller for their help in preparing for the arbitration.

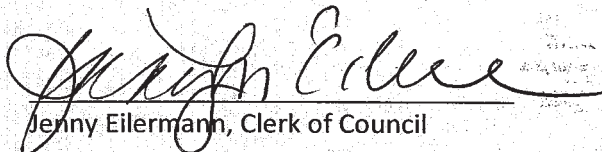
**Other Business** Ms. Hawk gave a report from the recent LSDMC meeting.

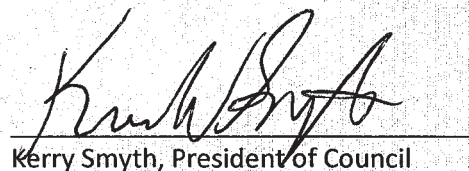
