Mr. Hardig was the sole opposing vote.

**Mayor Keller** had no report

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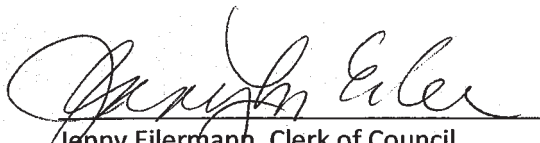
**Public Recognition:**

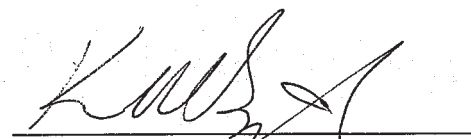
