

On September 5th 2023, the BUILDING ANNEXATION & ZONING COMMITTEE met to discuss the proposed Mural ordinance. The meeting began at 8:37pm. The main focus of the committee meeting was to hear and consider input, opinions and perspectives related to development of a proposed mural ordinance.

Law Director Kim Rohr shared a first draft of proposed legislation which was previously requested by the committee and discussed the procedure for adopting such legislation. A productive discussion followed and several aspects of the proposal were explored in detail including expanding the allowable locations to include all zoned business districts and not limiting them to only B-1. Also, Ideas were shared about limiting the number of mural licenses to a certain number per year, per district. Committee members were encouraged to review this first draft and to make recommendations for changes and clarifications by the next Zoning Committee meeting which will be held on October 17th 2023.

For the most part, these ideas were met with support and enthusiasm among all in attendance. The meeting was adjourned at 9:13pm.
