## CITY OF CHEVIOT STATE OF OHIO ORDINANCE NO. 22-

## TO AMEND SECTION 33.42 OF THE CHEVIOT CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, Section 33.42 of the Cheviot Code of Ordinances currently reads as follows:

§ 33.42 COMPENSATORY AND SICK TIME FOR FIRE CHIEF AND POLICE CHIEF.

- (A) All compensatory and sick time up to a maximum of 120 days shall be retained and protected on the books with respect to such sick time and compensatory time accumulated by the city's fire chief and police chief.
- (B) Upon retirement, the police chief and fire chief shall be eligible for payment of all accumulated sick time, not to exceed 1,020 hours.
- (Ord. 1430, passed 10-4-88; Am. Ord. 95-3, passed 1-17-95; Am. Ord. 06-28, passed 9-5-06)

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to amend the above-referenced ordinance to reduce the total amount of compensatory ("comp") time that the Fire Chief and Police Chief can accrue and retain to 120 hours after January 1, 2023, but to all the current Fire Chief and Police Chief to retain any current compensatory time that was earned prior to January 1, 2023 even if it exceeds 120 hours.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. Section 33.42 is hereby amended as follows:

§ 33.42 COMPENSATORY AND SICK TIME FOR FIRE CHIEF AND POLICE CHIEF.

- (A) All compensatory and sick time up to a maximum of 120 days shall be retained and protected on the books with respect to such sick time and compensatory time accumulated by the city's fire chief and police chief.
- (B) Upon retirement, the police chief and fire chief shall be eligible for payment of all accumulated sick time, not to exceed 1,020 hours.
- (C) Effective January 1, 2023, the total amount of compensatory time included in the maximum total set forth in Section (A) shall not exceed 120 hours of compensatory time. Any compensatory time accrued through December 31, 2022 shall be retained, even if said time exceeds 120 hours; however, additional compensatory time above 120 hours shall not be retained if it was earned on January 1, 2023 or later.

Section 2. Existing Section 33.42 of the Cheviot Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect at the earliest time allowed by law.
