CITY OF CHEVIOT STATE OF OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 24-13

TO CREATE NEW FUND; TO AMEND FUND NAME; TO ADD NEW LINE ITEMS; TO TRANFER FUNDS; TO AMEND THE 2024 ANNUAL BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to changes in Equitable Sharing Guidelines, the City must create new line items for federal seizures and a separate fund for Treasury and Justice; and

WHEREAS, it has become necessary to make adjustments to the appropriations of the 2024 annual budget by increasing and decreasing certain budget line items and transferring certain funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF ALL MEMBERS THEREOF CONCURRING, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> A new fund is hereby established for the revenues and expenditures associated with Federal Criminal Activity Forfeiture – Treasury, and said fund shall be identified as Criminal Activity/Forfeiture/Federal – Treasury (Fund. No. 214).

<u>Section 2</u>. The name of Criminal Activity/Forfeiture/Federal (Fund 209) is amended to Criminal Activity/Forfeiture/Federal – Justice.

Section 3. The following line items are established:

- 209.025.6 CAF Cash account- Justice
- 209.101.239.3 CAF Contract Incidentals- Justice
- 209.161.1 CAF Forfeitures- Justice
- 214.025.6 CAF Cash account- Treasury
- 214.101.239.3 CAF Contract Incidentals- Treasury
- 214.161.1 CAF Forfeitures- Treasury

<u>Section 4.</u> The sum of \$34,880.61 shall be transferred from Criminal Activity/Forfeiture/State (Fund 208) to Criminal Activity/ Forfeiture/Federal – Justice (Fund 209).

<u>Section 5.</u> The following sums shall be transferred:

The ZONING COMMITTEE meeting on April16th 2024, began at 8:00pm. The meeting was called to review discuss and evaluate the proposed legislation and zoning changes in regards to Marijuana Businesses in the city of Cheviot as it relates to the recent changes in Ohio law regarding Recreational Marijuana. In addition the committee reviewed proposed legislation and zoning changes regarding murals within the city.

The committee continues to express general support for this new legislation and after having submitted the proposed legislation on this issue to the Planning Commission at the beginning of April is pleased to know that the Commission is in agreement with the proposed legislation with a few minor tweaks to the legislation which include a more accurate description of the various business districts. The Law Director has included these language changes into the current proposed legislation and zoning changes which are now available for review by all parties.

The committee also continues to express support for Legislation and zoning changes in regards to the permitting of murals in the business district. The Law director will make a clarification to the description of the effected areas, and upon reviewing these changes the Zoning Commission has expressed support the proposed legislation concerning the Murals. As such, all interested parties may review and comment on the new proposal.
