RESOLUTION NO. 19 - 12**

TO APPROVE CERTAIN EXPENDITURES FROM THE CRIMINAL ACTIVITY/FORFEITURE FUND.

WHEREAS, in accordance with R.C. 2981.13, the City of Cheviot maintains a law enforcement trust fund, known as the "Criminal Activity/Forfeiture Fund," to receive and to expend monies which have been distributed through the forfeiture of assets and proceeds of criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, the Cheviot Police Department has requested that it be permitted to access the fund to purchase certain items for law enforcement purposes; and

WHEREAS, this council finds the request to be reasonable and in the best interest of the city;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHEVIOT, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


Section 1. The expenditure of money from the Criminal Activity/Forfeiture Fund for the following purposes is hereby approved:

- One new police cruiser;
- AR15 service rifles;
- Protective headgear.


Section 2. The expenditures authorized by Section 1 above shall not exceed the amount appropriated by Ordinance No. 19-08, passed by council on March 19, 2019.

Section 3. No money shall be expended from the fund until a new internal control policy is in place which complies with the requirements of Section 2981.13(C)(2) of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.




