WHEREAS, the City of Cheviot is planning to make capital improvements to Applegate Avenue Improvements; and


WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Transit Infrastructure Fund.


Section 1. The Safety-Service Director is hereby authorized to apply to the Transit Authority for funds as described above.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.






