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Council President Smyth called the meeting to order at 7:30PM with the Pledge of Allegiance and a moment of silent prayer. Roll was then called, and the following members were in attendance:

Law Director Rohr was detained in traffic and will be unable to attend tonight's meeting. Mr. Hartig's absence was excused with a motion by Mr. Smyth, second by Mr. Voss.

Mr. Smyth read into record his report from the Finance/Laws, Rules and Ordinances Committee meeting held on October 1. Following the report Mayor Keller interjected that the current earnings tax makes up one-sixth of the total city budget.

Minutes from the October 1 meeting were approved with a motion by Mr. Smyth, second by Mr. Voss.

No legislation was before council at this meeting.

ADMINISTRATIVE REPORTS:

-Mayor Keller reports that the punch list for the Harrison Ave road diet project has been sent to ODOT. Caroline Statkus' final day was October 15. The 250 Committee (for semiquincentennial) has been formed. Members are Amy Richter, Rich Martin and Bonnie Perrino. A \$1000 donation to the cause was received from the Cheviot Firemen's Association. The first meeting of the committee will be held Thursday, October 24, 6PM at Harves Home Lodge.

-Safety Service Director Braun reports that the current parking code needs to be updated to reflect changes since the installation of the new parking meters.

Other Business:

-Mr. Borgmann reported that Oktoberfest was successful. It was well attended.

-Mrs. Richter reminded that this Sunday, October 20, will be the 75th year anniversary of Maury's. A buffet dinner celebration is planned. The cost is \$19.49 per person, with proceeds benefitting the Rebold Foundation.

She also announced that Martifest, the annual fund raiser for St. Martin's Church will be held on November 9.

-The next meeting of the Cheviot Business Alliance will be in November at the Public House, lower level. The October meeting has been cancelled.

-Mr. Smyth reports that the Cheviot Police Association's soccer teams have had some success this year, with seven teams advancing to the state tournament. Two of the teams were undefeated during league play.

Mr. Smyth also acknowledged Mr. Braun for a job well done with negotiated utility rates through the aggregation program.

There will be no council meeting on Tuesday, November 5, as this is Election Day.

Treasurer's Report from September 2024 was received and filed with a motion by Mr. Smyth, second by Mr. Voss. Motion carried 6-0.


Mayor's Court receipts were received and filed with a motion by Mr. Smyth, second by Ms. Hawk. Motion carried 6-0.
