HOME STRONG: Protecting Your Legacy Through Resources for Existing Homeowners

The Cincinnati NAACP Housing Committee is collaborating with the Community Action Agency, Legal Aid, H.O.M.E., LISC, Pro Seniors, People Working Cooperatively, and the Cincinnati Association to host a pivotal event called "Home Strong: Protecting Your Legacy Through Resources for Existing Homeowners" sponsored by US Bank.

The primary objective of this event is to connect homeowners residing in high-risk communities susceptible to foreclosure with organizations that can provide information for the betterment of their legacy and overall ownership.
