-Mr. Smyth also encourages all to support Sue's Thai Restaurant which recently opened on Glenmore Ave.

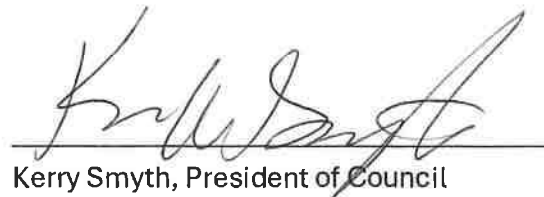
Correspondence:
